

## **Columbia Café Facts & Figures**

- Erected in 1932, this extended Craftsman Bungalow is located in the historic Highland district in Shreveport, LA, on one acre of land in one of the oldest neighborhoods in the city.
- Underwent a \$1 million renovation over the course of 10 years.
- An antique Vienna Regulator clock, built in Germany 265 years ago, rings on the quarter hour and has never failed; a Chicago World's Fair blue ribbon winning original Kranich and Bach Cabinet Grand piano is played every night. The piano was produced in 1896 and donated to the café in 2001. Less than 100 of its kind were created.
- Original classical and jazz music, daily.
- Multiple private rooms that accommodate anywhere from 6-24 people have been used for everything from deal making to celebrity's hide-away.
- Fresh grown herbs in the outdoor garden and other organic approaches have helped catapult it to becoming an area favorite.
